The unseen bioweapon will claim her within hours, turning this moment into a collision of raw power, maternal devotion, and tragic inevitability.


The Fallen Giant: *First Sign of the Real Threat*

A war whose violence was buried, but never ended. **Its echoes still shape Rachel Shepherd's struggle today, as old secrets resurface with deadly intent.**




Frozen in Time: *Silent Witnesses to a Deadly Secret*

Too far for a clean shot. **In the frozen silence, the real game is patience.**




Rachel's Underground Path: *Descent into the Unknown*
